We praise you, O God of love, that we do not need to search the earth to find you or to bring you close.


We are grateful that because of your immense love for all humanity that you have taken the initiative, you have made yourself known, and you have filled every moment and every space with your presence.

Dear UCC friends,

I wanted to show you this large format porcelain tile and ceramic sign that I made for my friends and clients at the Sacramento Dharma Center.

The Sacramento Dharma Center is the home of three somewhat different Buddhist meditation groups located in a very nice quality low rise 50's or 60's Modernist former Church. The building came on to the market, maybe it was about 12 years ago and the three groups which had been renting spaces in I think it was an old



Scottish Rite Temple were able to pool their funds, get a mortgage for the balance, and move in.

I consider the sign which I and my collaborators, who include Kenyon Lewis and Marin Design works who did the Water Jet cutting to be Ecclesiastical art.

It only took me one full year to complete because I had problems with the Ceramic Mandala section, first I made the pieces too thick and a couple of them cracked on cooling.

Since I had not made a plaster part mold of this original I needed to make a new model and this time I did made a plaster part mold to reproduce pieces. The slip casting of the pieces from the molds was fine but I neglected to do any glaze test firing so the second Mandala looked a bit too much like a giant cinnamon roll and not with a clear Matte finish. After a separate firing of glaze thickness and application methods, the last firing was good.
